Pax Christi Corner –A Reflection by Treasurer Chris

It would be impossible to even begin to comment on all the wonderful statements regarding the need for peace and justice in our world that Pope Benedict XVI has made over his visit. I would simply like to cite two statements made in his address to the United Nations Friday morning.

First " The promotion of human rights remains the most effective strategy for eliminating inequalities between countries and social groups, and for increasing security" bringing to the forefront the need for human rights in our world. He followed that by saying "Indeed, the victims of hardship and despair, whose human dignity is violated with impunity, become easy prey to the call to violence, and they can then become violators of peace" clearly linking the need for social justice to peace.

Many commentators noted that the Holy Father would be looking to connect with American Catholics over his visit. For those who have peace and justice concerns, he certainly caught their attention.
